Single control buttons: For controlling single circuit loads



The button toggles the lights ON and OFF, it becomes green when ON, and gray when OFF.

Group control buttons: For controlling grouped circuit loads




The button toggles the group of lights ON and OFF, it becomes blue when ON, and gray when OFF.

Scene control buttons: For activating a scene.



The button activates the scene to the assigned lights, when pressed it becomes blue momentarily to acknowledge activation and then returns to gray.



Setting the time:

Select the time field that is to be changed and use the numeric keypad to enter the desired time.



After changing the setting, the new value is stored automatically, no separate button needs to be pressed

Once the desired time is set, press <Enter> to accept the new time value.



When this screen appears, it means that the communication link to the CC500 device is down. Check and make sure that the terminal contacts on the touch panel and the CC500 are screwed securely and making good contact. Then check the physical communication cable to make sure that it is in good order.



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
